- N0453 Phal. Brother Cortez Red 'Steinfurt' AM/AOS \$25.  
 Phal. H. P. Norton 'Asheville'  
 Another gotta be reds!
- N0525 Phal. Krull's Red Hot 'Sizzle' x \$25.  
 Phal. H. P. Norton 'Orchidview'  
 Gotta' be red!
- N0527 Phal. H.P. Norton \$25 -  
 (Bro. Pirate King x  
 Krull's Red Hot 'Apopka' AM/AOS)  
 This is a remake of the original HP Norton using the same  
 Brother Pirate King, a yellow flower with red around the  
 column and some barring, as the pod parent. A different  
 Krull's Red Hot furnished the pollen.
- N0528 Phal. Orchidview Tabasco 'Pimlico' X \$25.  
 Phal. Brother Pirate King 'Frank'  
 Our Phal. Orchidview Tabasco is very similar to Phal.  
 H.P. Norton therefore this is a yellow/red put on a red flower.
- N0539 Phal. Kiss Me Kate 'Carol' x \$25.  
 Phal. H. P. Norton 'Copper Top' AM/AOS  
 Pod parent is Katie Morris x Neopolis, an old favorite of HP's x  
 one of the awarded H.P. Norton clones.
- N0554 Phal. Orchidview Tabasco Chipole' \$25  
 Phal. H.P. Norton 'Orchidview'  
 Another 'Gotta be Red' and they have been. A number of  
 Seedlings from this cross have already flowered.
- N0633 Phal. (Yellow Fantasy x Brother Golden Potential) x \$25.  
 Phal. Border's Gold 'Butterscotch'  
 Deep yellow with little or no barring.
- N0634 Phal. King's Ransom 'Golden Treasure' HCC/AOS x \$25.  
 Phal. Brother Golden Potential  
 Lovely presentation and branching. This should be a great step  
 ahead in yellow breeding.
- N0637 Phal. Brecko's Lemonbell 'Buttercup' HCC/AOS x \$25.  
 Phal. Border's Gold 'Butterscotch'  
 One of Mark Rose's famous yellows mated with the late Ralph  
 Border's best yellow/gold. Gotta be solid gold!

Phal. H. P. Norton 'Orchidview'

N0644 Phal. Pisgah Sands 'Yellow Bird' x \$25.  
Phal. Border's Gold 'Butterscotch'  
Another very good chance to flower outstanding yellows.

\*\*\*N0664 Phal. bellina 'Orchidview Blue' x  
Phal. violacea 'Blue Chip'

This is stepping into unproven territory. Both parents are as blue as a bellina or violacea can be but only One knows if we will have blue progeny. They are about to be set in 5 plant compots which we are offering for \$100.

Our standard compots were set with 10 plants and should have at least 8 plants growing. Some of these, especially those with N0500 numbers, are one of a kind and will go out first come, first served.
